 - (ii) To approve the change in the title of the compact MTE-12 from"Operations Research" to "Linear Programming", and to approve the syllabor of the course.
 - (iii) To approve the application priented course in Mathematics "Statistics and Operations Research" (8 credits)
 - 8.2.1: Regarding the course "Teaching of Mathematics", it was felt that a certificate for diploma programme concerning the teaching of mathematics should be

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developed and this course should be part of that programme. Simultaneously, it can be offered as an AOC in the BDP. It was decided that the work on the AOC 'Teaching of Mathematics' should continue as scheduled, and the detailed outline of the courses for the certificate programme should be worked out.

The course code AMT-1. and the course outline were approved.

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- 8.2.2.: Change of name of the course MTE-12 from "Operations Research" to "Linear Programming". and the syllabus, were approved.
- 8.2.3.: The AOC, "Statistics and Operations Research" proposed by the Mathematics faculty, and approved by the Mathematics Expert Committee, was approved.
