#### PROFILE

#### Early Life

Gaddam Ram Reddy was born in a small village, called Mylaram in the district of Karimnagar, Telangana, on December 4, 1929. His father Krishna Reddy was a farmer and his mother Kanthamma was a traditional hindu wife and had little or no education.

Prof.G.Ram Reddy was sent to Karimnagar for schooling and he took his first school lessons in Telgu and Urdu, the court language of the state of

Hyderabad. In school, he was a quiet observant, but shy pupil. He was very interested in games like football and volleyball. At school level, his favourite subjects were Mathematics and English. Passing matriculation was a challenging task at the time, but he became the first person from his village to complete matriculation.

#### **College Life**

He came to Hyderabad In 1949 for joining the famous Nizam College in Osmania University. For someone who was

educated in Urdu medium school in rural culture, learning all the subjects through English and struggling to adjust in urban culture was a great challenge, but he cleared the hurdle by his positive approach and hard work. Even he took part in college union. Prof Reddy completed his intermediate in 1953 and BA in 1955 with Economics, Political Science and History. Matured, poised and firmly committed to serve the society through academic pursuits, he completed his Master's Degree in Political Science in 1957 and soon become a lecturer in a

newly established private college in the town Nalgonda. In 1957, at the age of 28, he broadened his horizons with a burning ambition to study abroad. Thus, he left for London to study at the famed London School of Economics and completed M.Sc. in Public Administration in two years. These years were the most remarkable period of his life. The marvellous intellectual environment honed his academic skills and sharpened the art of communication. He got exposed to tremendous scholarship of intellectual giants like Harold Laski, Lionel Robbins,

W A Robson and Peter Self etc. He was influenced by Fabian socialism and became active supporter and party card holder of Labour Party of England who played a major role for India's independence. Harold Laski's writings and Krishna Menon's speech inspired him a lot.
